AWARDS, GRANTS & SCHOLARSHIPS

Applications are invited for the following **awards, grants and scholarships**.

Partnership in Practice, Scotland (PiPS)

Three awards of £2,000 each to community nurses demonstrating excellence and innovation in partnership working with other disciplines, voluntary sector, social services, patient groups or the community.

PiPs winners will be expected to use their award to develop their project further over the next 2 years. *Applications by 30th June*

Kuenssberg Scholarship

A bursary of £5,000 plus the cost of course fees, placement expenses, essential books and typing. Nurses must have an NMC registered qualification, at least two years post-registration experience, which includes one year of experience of working in the community, and have been accepted provisionally for an approved course in Nursing in the Home at Diploma/Degree level. *Applications by 30th June*

Brigid Stewart Scholarship

A bursary of £5,000 plus the cost of course fees, placement expenses, essential books and typing. Nurses must have an NMC registered qualification, at least two years post-registration experience, which includes one year of experience of working in the community, and have been accepted provisionally for an approved course leading to a community specialist practitioner nursing qualification at Diploma/Degree level. *Applications by 30th June.*

Further Education Grants

Applications will be considered for programmes of study with academic accreditation, relating to the relevant area of professional practice. Applicants must hold NMC registration recording specialist level Community Nursing, Public Health Nursing or Midwifery that is in current use, in a clinical capacity in Primary Care. *Applications by 30th June.*

Community Nursing Long Service Award

For applicants who have at least 21 years of employment within community nursing, ten of which must have been worked in Scotland. *Applications by 31st September*
